### Captured Moments & Memories

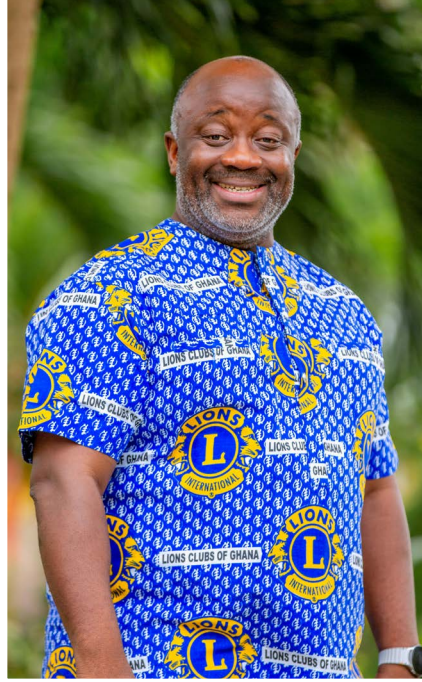
